

## Torch Description:

We are using a torch purchased from Midwest Trophy. It has a fiberglass wick, is 16 inches in length, weighs 3 lbs, and has a high-buffered silver aluminum body with a resin composite handle. At maximum saturation, the wick will burn for 30– 45 minutes [during the NYC event the torch stayed lit for well over 2 hrs by using lamp oil – see image on the right].



\* Please remove the plastic bag encasing the wick before lighting. You may, however, keep the tape on the top and bottom of the wick.

\* Please use lamp oil only, such as Coleman fuel.

\* Place the wick in the plastic container provided and add enough fuel [10oz] to fully saturate the wick.

\* When ready to light, remove the wick from the plastic container and install wick into torch bowl.

\* Discard excess fuel in the container.

\* Light the torch!

\* The torch can be extinguished by using the snuff cap.
