You've heard the call to action from our religious leaders. Now you can help the people of Darfur. Here are a few suggestions your community can use to take action.

Once your community decides its course of action, log onto www.SaveDarfur.org/faith and share what you are doing to help the people of Darfur. Learn from and inspire other faith groups.

Right Now: Prepare two stations for the audience to visit after viewing the film.

- 1) Write letters. Audience members at this station write a personal letter to their member of Congress urging them to work with the international community to prevent further delays in deploying peace keeping troops to Darfur.
- 2) Write prayers. Audience members at this station write prayers for Darfur, submit them to SaveDarfur.org/faith and use them the next time your community prays together.

- This Week:**
- 1) Become a part of the Save Darfur community. Sign up for Save Darfur Coalition's email list at www.savedarfur.org for regular updates and opportunities to take action.
 - 2) Spread the word. Tell friends, families and coworkers about what you heard today. Share the web site and encourage everyone to sign up on the Save Darfur email list.
 - 3) Hang a banner. Order "A Call to Your Conscience" banner at www.SaveDarfur.org and hang it in front of your place of worship to inspire fellow congregants as well as passers-by to take action for the people of Darfur.
 - 4) Pass "Darfur: A Call to Action – Lessons from Faith Leaders" on to one other place of worship.

 - 2) Divestment: Join the divestment movement at DivestforDarfur.org and encourage investment firms to withdraw from companies that help fund genocide in Darfur.
